Coda Mountain Academy

Coda Mountain Academy has been serving Fayette County, WV since 2007. Esther Morey, and her husband Robert, began Coda Mountain Academy when they witnessed significant struggles in their county with food insecurity, poverty, and drugs. Coda Mountain Academy lives and breathes the mission of community transformation, by recognizing that the pillars of family, education, wellness, leadership, and faith are interwoven. Through their diverse and innovative programs, they have seen transformational and sustainable change across their community.

In 2022, Coda Mountain Academy:

- Served 500+ youth and families
- Offered 25 weeks of after-school programming
- Operated four weeks of summer camps
- Provided 12 weeks of grandparent support groups
- Engaged youth in drug prevention programs
- Assisted youth by providing academic support

Prayer requests from Coda Mountain Academy:

- Revival that will reignite the partnerships between Coda, the community, and area schools.
- Continued favor with the community and area schools.
- Coda Revive - a program for youth seeking to explore/strengthen their faith - to grow spiritually and in numbers.

FBC Asheboro has been sending mission teams to support Coda Mountain Academy projects since 2015. These trips have primarily been construction endeavors. This facility is used daily for Lego robotics, music/art classes, and Bible study.
