In 2018, First Baptist Church began assessing needed improvements and renovations by appointing the Facilities Review Committee. Since then, our church has experienced Covid disruptions and major staff changes putting the renovation process on hold. Throughout this time, the Facilities Review Committee, chaired by Charles Havens, has continued to plan, pray, and prepare.

Ecclesiastes reminds us there is a time and a season for all things. God has now opened doors, answered prayers, and set circumstances in motion, allowing the committee to present an updated plan on **January 21** at **6:10 pm**. This plan focuses on renovating our 65-year-old educational building.

All these reasons are absolutely right and valid! I am sure we can even add dozens and hundreds of other reasons to read the Bible. The #1 reason I personally read the Bible is because it draws me closer to God. When I spend time in His Word, my eyes are open to who He is and who He is calling me to be. It makes me aware of how He is working all around me. It shows me how to turn to Him in my time of need; and it calls me out when I am wandering off to the wrong path. When I read through God's Word, I draw closer to Him as I am focused on my daily walk with Him!

I would love to say I have always been perfectly obedient in reading His Word daily, but honestly, it was a hard discipline for me to learn and still is a struggle some days. Let me remind all of us what Matthew 4:4 tells us. Jesus had fasted forty days and forty nights, and He was hungry. Satan tries to tempt Him to make His own food, giving into His fleshly cravings. Jesus responds to Satan by saying, "It is written: Man must not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of God." The Word of God has more value than the food we eat! The Bible is essential for daily life! The Word of God is really that important.

So, I want to invite you as we journey together through the Word of God. We will begin a reading plan together to read the whole Bible in a year. Now the goal is not to just finish the plan and check it off the list; it is to journey together. Some might need to take a little longer and some might go a little faster. Let's strive to read God's Word **together** so we draw closer to God and to each other.


Amazing Race—January 23
