John 17:20-23 (NIV)

 20 "My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, 21 that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me. 22 I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one— 23 I in them and you in me—so that they may be brought to complete unity. Then the world will know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me."

These amazing verses come from Jesus' prayer right before he is about to be betrayed, arrested, beaten, and eventually crucified. He was praying for those who would believe in him because of the message the disciples would share. That prayer is for you and me! At one of the heaviest moments in all of human history, Jesus was focused on us.

This idea is comforting, overwhelming and convicting. He chose to die for us!

And as we look at his words, notice something else of great importance. Jesus prays "that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you . . . so that they may be brought to complete unity. Then the world will know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me." Jesus prayed for our unity. He prayed we would have unity like he has with the Father – complete oneness! Hear that last part again – "Then the world will know that you sent me."

Wow! The world will believe in Jesus because of the unity of his believers. Unity is essential to the gospel. So, I invite you this month to join us as we seek to learn how to be more unified both in our church and with Christians around the world. As we have talked about being a disciple which calls for us to die to ourselves, take up our cross and follow him, we have seen this is not possible without love. Without love, we are nothing! Now as we seek to love one another more, we'll discover the importance of unity. I invite you to journey together on this path toward greater unity, because the gospel depends on it!


