These beautiful lyrics are what we call the Doxology. These words might be the best-known lyrics in all Christian hymnology and poetry. Seemingly simple, they are overflowing with truth.

First, hear how the lyrics start reminding us that all blessings flow from God. James 1:17 illustrates this truth when it says, "Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows." Everything good is from God and he is worthy of our praise!

Also, note who is praising God in the Doxology. All creatures are praising him! *Philippians 2:9-11 tells us,*"Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, <sup>10</sup> that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, <sup>11</sup> and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father." Not only is he worthy of our praise, when God in all his glory returns through Jesus, no one will be able to hold back from acknowledging who God truly is by falling on their knees to praise him!

Finally, hear the beautiful reminder of how we are to praise the whole Trinity. Praise Father, Son, and Holy Ghost. We are to praise God in his fulness.

Over the next several months, our goal is going to be to praise God in the fulness of the Trinity. Each month we will spend time looking at how God reveals himself through being God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. For the month of February, we will look at God the Father.

I invite you to join us on Sunday mornings as we seek to know the character of God better. As we engage in understanding his character more, we will draw more intimately into our relationship with him. Let us praise God together! Will you join us?

15 Years of Service at FBC

Rick Davis, an Asheboro native, once balanced his life as a cartoonist in a Church Street building and a Produce Manager at Walmart. However, a profound concern for his high school friends who hadn't found faith in the Lord led him to make a significant life change. With the assistance of Frank White, he co-founded the "Soda Shop Ministry" outreach, creating a safe haven for those seeking answers to their spiritual questions. Rick's commitment to this endeavor eventually led him to transition from part-time to full-time service as our Associate Pastor at HeartSpace Ministries for our church.

Throughout the years, Rick has played a pivotal role in initiating numerous small groups dedicated to spiritual growth, recovery ministries, and lifeenriching Bible studies. His ability to care for those that are so often overlooked by others has brought many people to know the Lord. In addition, HeartSpace, AWE (Alternative Worship Experience) was created and is overseen by Rick. Most recently, The Shadow of the Cross Baptist Church, was brought to Rick's attention. This church in Asheboro was slowly dying and needed help. As a result of Rick's leadership, it is now growing and has a vision for their future.

In 2015 Rick became a full-time staff member. He continues to love the people in Asheboro who are

burdened with life and introducing them to the Lord. Many have joined our church because of his compassion and love for the lost. Thank you, Rick, for all you have done for so many people in our community.
