The Thailand Mission Team will travel to and be serving in the city and province of Songkhla, Thailand from July 31 to August 10. Songkhla is in the southernmost part of the country, close to the Malaysian border.

Serving on the Thailand Mission Team are Patti Cahoon, Bill, Kendra, and Anna Cranford, Philip and Lindsey Lahr, and Ann Spencer. The primary focus of the trip will be assisting career missionaries from the International Mission Board (IMB) in sharing the Gospel and teaching what it means to be a Christian using the book titled, *City Talk*.

The team has several priorities while visiting Thailand. They will begin by connecting with locals and children of the Songkhla community to help them learn the basics of the English language and American culture, while also engaging in fun activities such as line dancing and singing. During this time, they will also have an opportunity to teach local school children about Christ, the Bible, and Christianity as they visit a local church.

The Thailand Mission Team also hopes to visit with senior citizens at the local senior center, as well as inmates at the local prison, with the hope of sharing encouragement

and prayer. At the new community center, the team hopes to build relationships with college-age and young adults through assisting with paddle-board lessons. Finally, they plan to visit with area Baptist churches for a time of prayer and encouragement as they strive to plant new churches in and around Songkhla, Thailand. The team will also be working in the city of Hat Tai as well.
