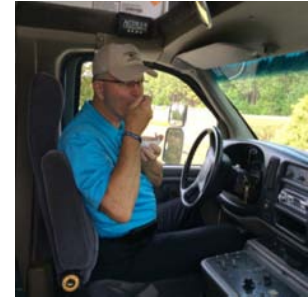


# SENIOR TRAVELERS TRIP
